## Proxy Form

### Before you fill in this form please read the accompanying notes.

1. You may either:

  - b. appoint the Chairman of the meeting. You appoint the Chairman as your proxy by ticking box below (The Chairman of the meeting may act for an unlimited number of members).

### How will your proxy vote?

You can direct your proxy how to vote using the Proxy Form.

- ▶ If you have given a directed proxy, any vote your proxy exercises on your behalf must be as you have directed.
- ▶ If your proxy has 2 or more appointments that specify different ways to vote on the Resolution, the proxy is not allowed to vote on a show of hands, but may vote on a poll.
- ▶ If you do not give any directions, your proxy can decide how to vote.
- ▶ If your proxy is the Chairman of the meeting and you do not give any direction on how to vote, the Chairman will exercise your vote in favour of Resolution 2b) – Remuneration of Directors.

### Signing

The Proxy Form must be signed by the member or on the member's behalf under an appropriate authority (such as power of attorney). It need not be witnessed.

If the member is a corporation, the Proxy Form must be signed under the common seal of the company, or by 2 directors, or 1 director and the company secretary, or by a sole director/secretary, or by an authorised officer or attorney. If the corporation has a sole director/secretary, it must state this fact on the proxy form or appointment of authorised officer.

If signed by an attorney or authorised officer, the authority under which the Proxy Form is signed (or a certified copy of it) must be provided to the Society with the Proxy Form.

### Timing

For the appointment of a proxy to be effective, your Proxy Form (and any original authority or a certified copy of it) must be received by the Society by:
